**Recreation and Recreation Plus**  
**Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)**

**Q. What is the difference between Recreation and Recreation Plus?**

A. There are several differences between Recreation and Recreation Plus but the biggest difference is that Recreational teams play soccer within their own community where as Recreational Plus teams can travel and play teams from other communities. Both programs offer greater flexibility than competitive soccer because the club/team creates their own schedule.

**Q. How do I find a recreational club?**

**Q. Are there any festivals that recreation teams can participate in?**

A. MYSA hosts at least one Recreation/Recreation Plus event each year. **Q. Do Recreational players get passes? Do Recreational Plus players get passes?**

A. Recreational players do not get passes. Recreational Plus players do get passes once the appropriate information has been submitted to MYSA.

**Q. What is the cost of registering players with MYSA?**

A. Recreation and Recreation Plus players have a \$6.50 per player basic registration fee. This fee goes to a number of things, one being insurance for the player. In addition, Recreation Plus players pay \$6.50 per player for a pass and a team registration fee of \$25.00.
