

Please follow the below guidelines and instructions to register and officiate MYSA games.

Register to the SRC

- All Referees in Minnesota are required to register through the Minnesota State Referee Committee (SRC). Referees will complete their Background check through this process. Additional information on the SRC can be found [here](#).

Register to MYSA's Referee Pool

- If a referee plans to officiate Minnesota Youth Soccer Association (MYSA) games, they are also required to complete a registration to MYSA's Referee Pool for the current year. This is necessary in order to access the Digital Player Cards (DPC) referees use to assign, score, and report on MYSA games. Referees will complete their MYSA Referee Pool Registration [here](#).

Access Digital Player Cards for MYSA games

- Once a referee has successfully registered with both the SRC and MYSA Referee Pool, they will be able to access the Digital Player Cards and Scoring to self-assign, complete check-ins, and enter scores for their matches. Click [here](#) to access the DPC and login as a referee:
